WELCOME TO THE JAZZ HOUSE KIDS SUMMER WORKSHOP!

For two weeks each August, the JAZZ HOUSE Summer Workshop immerses students in the art of jazz performance and helps them become well-rounded musicians through workshops, ensemble performances and jam sessions with professional musicians.

Students of all levels receive mentoring and top-notch instruction to develop key skills and enhance knowledge in fundamentals of music and the art of performance, for both instrumental musicians and vocalists. Highlights include masterclasses, small group and big band ensembles, history and culture, composition and film scoring. Students perform at Jazz at Lincoln Center's Dizzy's Club, Leshowitz Recital Hall at MSU and the MONTCLAIR **JAZZ** FESTIVAL, which attracts an audience of 10,000 jazz fans.

The camp provides a safe environment where young musicians are mentored by an array of acclaimed faculty and visiting guest artists. Together, emerging musicians create musical bonds and memories that will last a lifetime.

REGISTRATION

A non-refundable deposit is required at time of enrollment to secure your spot.* Early Bird registrations must be paid in full by March 15.

TUITION ASSISTANCE

Tuition assistance is based on financial need. Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis and assistance is granted on a first-come, first-served basis. Apply early, as funds are limited. Deadline for applications is May 31st. For more information, please call or apply online.

SUMMER WORKSHOP PLACEMENT AUDITIONS

Submission Window April 1-30

Placement Auditions are done through YouTube video link submissions. The placement videos ensure that you are placed in ensembles and classes that meet your needs and level. Students must submit a video audition to participate in the program. Videos taken from a cell phone are adequate quality. Cancellation Policy:

There is a 100% refund until June 1st. There is a 50% refund June 2 - July 15th. Please note, refund is less the \$125 initial deposit & registration fee. We do not offer any refunds beyond July 15th.

AUDITIONS FOR 2020-2021 CLASSES AT THE JAZZ HOUSE

One video submission works for all ensemble placements for the JAZZ HOUSE Summer Workshop, Fall classes at the JAZZ HOUSE, and the JAZZ HOUSE Big Band. Visit www.jazzhousekids.org for music submission guidelines. Submission window is April 1-30. Announcements will be made in late August. A full year commitment is required. Rehearsals start September 2020. Enrollment in the JAZZ HOUSE Summer Workshop is not required to audition for the big bands.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Can my child attend 1-week only?

No, the program is a 2-week commitment

Q: Do all students need to audition?

Yes, all students will need to audition for appropriate level placement in the JAZZ HOUSE Summer Workshop. Placement auditions will be done through YouTube video submissions, due between April 1-30. Q: Are students allowed to leave the premises anytime during the day?

For safety reasons, students are required to stay at the facility for the duration of the day.

Q: Are lunches provided?

Lunch is not provided. Students must bring their own lunch. If you are interested in purchasing lunch, you must pre-order through Student Services by July 15. Lunch will not be sold during the Workshop.

Q: What do students wear?

Comfortable clothing and soft-soled shoes are advised.

Q: Is individual instruction available?

Yes, one-on-one instruction is available for an additional charge. Sign up is required in advance.

Q: Is before-and after-care available?

Before-care is not available. The JAZZ HOUSE Summer Workshop features a FREE open jam session every day from 5:00-6:00pm. Students must be picked up by 6:00pm, no exceptions.

Q: Is need-based tuition assistance available?

Yes, JAZZ HOUSE **KiDS** believes that all students deserve access to great arts experiences — apply early as funds are limited.

SUMMER WORKSHOP FACILITY

The JAZZ HOUSE Summer Workshop makes its home in the beautiful, state-of-the-art Cali School of Music facility at Montclair State University. The 1928 Spanish mission style building was renovated and expanded in 2009, and is named in honor of the late John J. Cali, whose family's generous \$5 million gift provides scholarships and faculty support to Montclair State University's School of Music. John and Rose Cali have also been longtime friends of JAZZ HOUSE **KiDS**.

The Cali School of Music building offers well-appointed classrooms, rehearsal studios, practice rooms (all outfitted with Steinway pianos), and the 235-seat Jed Leshowitz Recital Hall, where our students, faculty and special guests will perform.
